TLPG Extends Services to the South

Lexington, Kentucky

Teaming with Design Collaborative and Irmscher Construction, TLPG recently completed the Master Plan for Married Student Housing at Asbury Theological Seminary in Asbury Kentucky, located just south of Lexington. Developed on 32 acres of rolling terrain, the plan includes 64 Townhomes and 103 Row House Units. The design utilizes 'New Urbanism' principles, and focuses on generous, green open spaces, a vast pedestrian walk system, front porches facing the village green, and a Family Life Center to promote a strong sense of community.



New Family Park Nears Completion

Fort Wayne, Indiana

The new Parkview Family Park, a 25-acre passive park on the north side of Fort Wayne, is nearing completion of construction. The park development is scheduled to open in the spring of 2009. Park amenities include a fully-accessible playground, adult fitness equipment, a 2,600 square-foot pavilion and restroom facility, one mile of hike/bike trails, and an overlook/stage with amphitheater style seating.

The LandPlan Group's role on the project is that of lead project designer, and TLPG oversees the consultants who provide architectural, electrical and irrigation design services. The new park replaces a park located within the construction zone of the new Parkview Regional Medical Center, which TLPG is currently providing site design services.
